
# Categories of housing needs

- Population and Employment Trends
   Growth, wages, industries
- Household Characteristics
   Overpayment, ELI and LI households
- Housing Stock Characteristics
  - Overcrowding, housing conditions (rehab, replacement, substandard), vacancy rates, costs
- Special Housing Needs Analysis
  - People with disabilities including developmental, seniors, large households, farmworkers, female headed housing households, homelessness, other

Four Data Points You Need to Add to the Housing Needs Section

Note: More information on these additional data points can be found in the Housing Needs Data Packet



- 1. Local data on homelessness
  - a. Housing Needs Data Packet has county-level data from HUD, but additional data for jurisdictions is needed.
- 2. Affordable properties at risk of conversion
  - a. Housing Needs Data Packet has total number of units, not specific properties. This data is available from California Housing Partnership.
- 3. Local data on substandard housing and rehab needs
  - a. Housing Needs Data Packet has some relevant census data, but local data from code enforcement or other sources is also needed.
- 4. Projected ELI Households
  - a. Housing Needs Data Packet contains guidance for calculating, but you will need your jurisdiction's final RHNA number to do the calculation.



#### 5 HOUSING STOCK CHARACTERISTICS

#### 5.1 Housing Types, Year Built, Vacancy, and Permits

In recent years, most housing produced in the region and across the state consisted of single-family homes and larger multi-unit buildings. However, some households are increasingly interested in "missing middle housing" - including duplexes, triplexes, townhomes, cottage clusters and accessory dwelling units (ADUs). These housing types may <u>open up</u> more options across incomes and tenure, from young households seeking homeownership options to seniors looking to downsize and age-in-place.

The housing stock of Oakland in 2020 was made up of 42.4% single family detached homes, 4.0% single family attached homes, 18.7% multifamily homes with 2 to 4 units, 34.5% multifamily homes with 5 or more units, and 0.3% mobile homes (see Figure 19). In Oakland, the housing type that experienced the most growth between 2010 and 2020 was *Multifamily Housing: Five-plus Units*.

Production has not kept up with housing demand for several decades in the Bay Area, as the total number of units built and available has not yet come close to meeting the population and job growth experienced throughout the region. In Oakland, the largest proportion of the housing stock is built 1939 or earlier, with 65,105 units built during this period (see Figure 20). Since 2010, 1.8% of the current housing stock was built, which is 3,113 units.







# Building blocks of a(n ACS) census table

- Topic / Table
  - General Search ('Income')
  - Specific Search ('B19001'; 'DP05')
- Geography
  - One or more geographies
- Year
  - 2010-ish to 2019







# Using Basic Search - App mostly infers building blocks

- "Google" of census: One box to rule them all?
- Start typing, **slowly** see suggestions in **real time**
- The app will fill in (mostly) sensible defaults based on search

- Good for topic discovery but Table IDs are useful to have handy
- But point of Advanced Search is more control of building blocks
