Cargo Way Planning Study (\$75,000)*

Eden Landing Bay Trail (\$163,588)*

Consideration of a \$163,588 construction grant request from the East Bay Regional Park District for the construction of approximately 2.94 miles of new Bay Trail spine at the Eden Landing Ecological Preserve in Hayward.

Oliver Gap Bay Trail (\$87,500)*

Consideration of an \$87,500 construction grant request from the East Bay Regional Park District for the construction of approximately 900 linear feet of trail along the edge of the Oliver Salt Works property located in Hayward connecting to the Eden Landing Ecological Preserve.

West County Wastewater District Bay Trail (\$150,000)*

Consideration of a \$150,000 construction grant request from the East Bay Regional Park District for construction of approximately 1.08 miles of trail along the western and northern perimeters of the West County Wastewater District facility in Richmond.
