

RESOLUTION NO. 10-10

**IN SUPPORT OF SB 1205 ON THE
BAY AREA DISASTER RECOVERY PLANNING COUNCIL**

WHEREAS, the Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG) sponsored SB 1205 (Corbett) to establish the Bay Area Regional Disaster Recovery Council (Council) in the San Francisco Bay Area through the enactment of State legislation; and

WHEREAS, SB 1205 directs the Council to create a long-term regional disaster recovery plan by cooperating with various stakeholders in the San Francisco Bay Area, including, but not limited to cities, counties, special districts, school districts, emergency managers, hospitals, members of the public, private business, and nongovernmental organizations; and

WHEREAS, one of the exceptions to the requirement for State reimbursement of mandated local costs found in Article XIII B of the State Constitution is for "Legislative mandates requested by the local agency affected"; and

WHEREAS, the Association of Bay Area Governments has requested the enactment of SB 1205.
