Bullet Points for RHNA Subregions

- We are currently planning for the fifth Regional Housing Need Determination and Allocation process
- As the council of governments, ABAG is responsible for the Bay Area's RHNA
- By law, jurisdictions can form subregions – typically, it's the county and the cities/towns within that county
- By forming a subregion, a group of jurisdiction takes on the responsibilities for creating a housing need allocation for their geographic area
- Three subregions have submitted formal requests by yesterday's deadline indicating that they would like to form
- Each jurisdictions in Napa, San Mateo, and Solano counties have submitted resolutions from their respective councils

- One of table **handouts** tonight shows the updated dates and milestones for the RHNA process for both the region as a whole and for the subregions
- The next major deadline for the region and for the subregions is to adopt draft proposed **methods** this summer
- ABAG staff will **assist** the subregions whenever possible
- The 46-member SCS **Housing Methodology Committee** has been meeting monthly since January – some of you are part of that committee
- We recommend that the subregions continue to attend and participate at these monthly meetings
- At this time, staff is recommending that we **adopt** **resolution number 03-11** which acknowledges the formation of RHNA subregions
- This resolution also **authorizes negotiation** and **execution** of a delegation agreement between ABAG and each of the RHNA subregions
