

Notice of Public Hearing

Bay Area citizens are invited by the Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG) to attend a public hearing on the Draft Regional Housing Needs Allocation (RHNA) appeals.

The RHNA Appeals Committee met on February 27, 2008. Those jurisdictions wishing to appeal their housing needs allocations were each given time to make a presentation to the committee. A memorandum reporting the outcome of the committee meeting will be produced for the March 20, 2008, ABAG Executive Board meeting. The memorandum will be available for public review on March 10, 2008.

A public hearing on the appeals is scheduled as part of the March ABAG Executive Board meeting. The Executive Board will be asked to consider the Appeals Committee's recommendations and any public comments in making their decision on the appeals. The Final RHNA allocation will be issued in May.
