This notice advises agencies and the public that the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), in accordance with Section 176 of the Clean Air Act 42 U.S.C. 7506, and the EPA general conformity regulations 40 CFR Part 93, Subpart B, has prepared a Final Conformity Determination (FCD) for the Cloverdale Rancheria of Pomo Indians' (Tribe) proposed 61.83-acre trust acquisition and resort casino project in unincorporated Sonoma County, California. This Proposed Action was previously analyzed in a Draft and Final Environmental Impact Statement prepared pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act issued August 6, 2010 and April 18, 2014, respectively. The Draft Conformity Determination was made available for public review and comment for a 30-day period beginning February 12, 2015. No comments were received on the Draft Conformity Determination.
