Mountain View Cemetery seeks development of portion of the less developed upper one-third of the cemetery to accommodate projected future need for additional burial sites. The proposed project includes development plans for three separate but interrelated development plots on the Cemetery property, all of which are entirely within the City of Oakland and the cemetery property. Each of the new development sites will be connected to the others by extensions of existing on-site roadways. The intent of the project is to develop new burial lots that are moderately flat, but which provide a gentle pitch to the west, offering panoramic views of the San Francisco Bay Skyline. The environmentalreview process is consistent with CEQA and local requirements.

The improvements consist of physical projects, programmatic activities and changes to city policies and practices.
