Project: Got Ants? Outreach to Reduce Water Quality Impacts from Urban Residential Ant Control
 The issue is ideally positioned for a successful systematic, large-scale outreach campaign focused on consumers: number of high-quality technical informational resources on less-toxic, IPM approaches to ant control have already been developed, but there has been little distribution to date of this body of material. An outreach campaign will address immediate, continuing impacts while longer-term solutions are addressed through the regulatory arena. Initial outreach efforts by SFEP from 2009-11 (about 500 "hits" including 100 in person) show very little public awareness of water quality impacts of ant control.
